

McGregor Families,

Thank you everyone for being patient as we go through this difficult time during the COVID-19 pandemic. I am sure everyone is eager to visit their loved ones. As everyone is aware, nursing home facilities will be permitted to begin outdoor visitation on July 20th, as long as all safety standards are met. When visiting your loved ones please keep in mind:

- Visits will be limited only to immediate family to the residents' physical and emotional well-being.
- All visits need to be scheduled in advance and will last no more than 30 minutes.
- Visitation days will go as follow: Monday 1st floor visitation, Wednesday 2nd floor visitation & Friday 3rd floor visitation.
- Visitation times are scheduled from: 10:30 am- 11:00 am, 11:15 am -11:45 am, 2:00-pm 2:30 pm & 2:45 pm -3:15 pm.
- Only 2 visitors per resident will be allowed per week to ensure all residents are receiving visits from their loved ones.
- Children under the age of 12 will be restricted.
- Visitors must be actively screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and must attest to COVID-19 status if known. This will be done at a designated location outside the building.
- Visitors must wear a mask, or other face covering, during the entire visit.
- No food allowed during visitation.
- Visitors must use alcohol-based hand rub upon entering and exiting the visitation area.
- Visitors may not walk through the facility to get to the outdoor visitation area.
- Visitors must sign in and provide contact information.
- Due to the risk of exposure, holding hands, hugging, kissing, or other physical contact is not allowed during family visits.
- All visitors must maintain 6 feet social distance and will be monitored by staff.
- Visitors must stay in designated visitation locations.

*A Sign will be posted to direct visitors to the designated visiting area. Please be prompt since all visits have a scheduled beginning and end time. *

Weather: Visits will occur only on days when there are no weather warnings that would put either the visitor or resident at risk. **Heat Wave: 90° F or higher and high humidity 80 percent relative humidity or higher.**

McGregor has the right to deny outdoor visitation to specific residents only if they believe:
1. Circumstances pose a risk of transmitting COVID-19 to the facility because the resident or visitor does not comply with infection control guidance, or resident or visitor is at risk of abuse/harm.
